We familiarize you with the lodge and time permitting we zero in the rifle/s to start your hunt as soon as we can.

Early mornings and late in the afternoons on an open hunting truck can get cool. To be comfortable we suggest that you pack the following:

Things To Pack – Attire

3 pairs of hunting long pants, 3 pairs of shorts, 4 bush shirts

Down jacket, jersey, and windbreaker

2 pairs comfortable hunting boots

4 pairs woollen socks

Bush hat, or cap, gloves, and a light weight rain coat

Comfortable sweatpants and T- shirt for relaxing around the campfire at night.

Camouflage colours are permitted in South Africa. If you do not have camouflage clothing then please ensure that your outfits are dark green or any dull colour. Laundry is done on a daily basis.

Things To Pack – Tech

Binocular & camera

Own 120 volt to 220 volt electric converter or a vehicle plug charger for charging batteries

International travel adapters for Africa

Personal toiletries, medicines, sun block, insect repellent and sunglasses.

For January - March bring one pair of rain gear as we might get showers some afternoon.

High 90° F | Low 60° F

Rifles | Ammunition & Scopes

Ammunition

Choice of bullet make should be Swift-A Frame, Woodleigh, Barnes X, Nosler partition or Hornady soft nose.

Scope

Choose a good quality variable scope to use on your rifle, as a suggestion 3x9 power is sufficient in Swarovski, Leica etc.

Rifles

A .375: versatile calibre, can be used on every plains game species as well. Soft noise ammunition especially on Big Five Species.

A minimum calibre of .375 to hunt any of the Big 5 (Lion, Buffalo, Rhino, Elephant, Leopard).

A .300 Win mag, 338, 7mm, 30-06 and the like are best suited for African antelope and for all plains game species.

Bring the rifle that you shoot best. Our preference is more about good shot placement over high powered firearm.





Please Note

To make it a less stressful and carefree trip we have a great range of rifles for you to use so you don't have to stress with getting your guns out and back into your country of origin. Feel free to chat with us regarding your weapon of choice should you choose to take advantage of our gun range.
